



# 2012 WASA Honorary Awards State Awards Nomination Form

## Call for STATEWIDE Nominations

Throughout its history, WASA has been involved in honoring and recognizing outstanding educational administrators and those individuals in other professions who have made extraordinary contributions to K–12 education. The association annually presents nine awards to recognize people and groups who have impacted education in the state of Washington. These include four statewide awards: Golden Gavel, Barbara Mertens Legacy, Service to WASA, and WASA Leadership awards. The region awards include the Award of Merit, Student Achievement Leadership, Community Leadership, Twenty-Year, and Retirement.

The statewide awards will be presented on June 25, 2012, at the WASA awards luncheon during the AWSP/WASA Summer Conference. Region awards will be presented during individual region award ceremonies. WASA members are encouraged to send in nominations for the various awards and previous nominations may be resubmitted. The nominations gathered will be given to

the WASA Honorary Awards Committee for consideration and final selection.

### The Committee will make the following considerations for statewide awards:

- Could the nominee be considered a positive change agent in public education at the state level?
- Has the nominee positively affected one or more areas—program development, staff morale, community support, student interest, learning environment, or general support for public education?
- Has the nominee provided creative leadership in inspiring or motivating others to achieve or contribute to public education?
- Has the nominee personally provided a special service or achieved above and beyond what is expected in the usual public school program?
- Have others recognized the nominee as a force for constructive change in public education at the community and/or state level?

One recipient per year (award not necessarily given every year).* **Award:** *Plaque with golden gavel.*
