

Bill Watch


Each week in TWIO, we track bills that are moving through the legislation. A bill's "status" changes as it is heard in committees and then either dies or moves on to the floor of the House or Senate. It then crosses over to the opposite house and goes through the same process. Bills, including sponsors, amendments, action and history can be found by clicking on the bill number. In the bill page, scroll down and click on the last item under "Bill Documents". You can view a shorter bill analysis under "Bill Reports". Again, the last item relates to the bill in its current status.

February 5 is the first committee cutoff. It is the last day to hear bills in the house of origin policy committees. February 9 is the last day for a bill to be heard in its house or origin budget committee to remain "alive". The bills in Bill Watch are still moving.
