Chapter 6, Section 504(2)(c) of the biennial budget act, directs the Superintendent of Public Instruction to prepare an analysis of travel times for students to contiguous school districts. The analysis included small schools receiving bonus units under section 502 of this act.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report is presented in response to, Chapter 6, Section 504(2)(c), Laws of 1994, 1st Special Session. Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill 6244.

Chapter 6, Section 504(2)(c), Laws of 1994, 1st Special Session required the following: *“Regarding small schools receiving bonus units under section 502 of this act, for comparison purposes, prepare an analysis of travel times for students to contiguous school districts. The analysis shall be submitted to the office of financial management and the fiscal committees of the legislature by December 1, 1994.”*

Comparisons of estimated travel times for existing school bus routes and alternative bus routes to contiguous schools are presented in Appendix D. These data, in spreadsheet format, are also included on a computer disk.

A visual (graphic) database was used for calculating the travel times for existing bus routes and alternative routes to contiguous schools. The report is based on school bus routes submitted for funding by school districts for the 1994-95 school year.

Process

School districts receiving small school district bonus funding for the 1994-95 school year were identified (see Appendix A). These districts were requested to return their school bus route maps and related data initially submitted for the 1993-94 school year transportation operations funding. These materials were then reviewed by the Regional Transportation Coordinators in preparation for entering the 1994-95 data.

The following chart displays the school districts that received small district bonus funding for the 1993-94 school year.

This reduced size chart is provided for quick reference. A full size copy of this chart is included as Appendix A.

The review of these data determined that some of the school(s) or school district(s) should be eliminated from the process because of unusual geographic barriers making travel to a contiguous district impractical or unreasonable. Anderson Island and Harriet Taylor Elementary Schools in the Steilacoom Historical School District and all school districts in San Juan County were eliminated because ferry travel across water creates unrealistic scheduling requirements. Stehekin School District was eliminated for a similar reason due to its isolated location at the end of Lake Chelan.

Use of Current Year Data

Initial consideration was given to eliminating other school districts because of extreme travel times. This was rejected because the purpose of the study was to provide a comparison of travel times for current routes versus routes to contiguous school districts.

The visual database that was used to do this report took more time to develop than anticipated. Getting all of the roadways in Washington converted to a usable format was not completed until September. An advantage of this delay is that it allowed the use of the most recent available data. Therefore, this report is based on actual 1994-95 school bus routes. One outcome is that Ocean Beach School District in Pacific County is not included in this report due to an increase in enrollment over last year that moved it out of the small school classification.

Procedures Used

The Regional Transportation Coordinators transferred the hand-drawn school bus routes submitted by these school districts to the roadway network contained in the computer database. This required locating each of the following points: school building, the school bus stops feeding into that school building, and the school bus routes used. Then the roadway links were connected to measure the distance traveled by the bus to the existing school building. The estimated speed traveled by the school bus on each segment of roadway was entered by the coordinator as these data elements were entered.

This study consistently made one of three assumptions regarding road speed:

1. Twenty miles per hour on all roadway links with school bus stops.
2. Thirty-five miles per hour was used in most other cases except for uninterrupted travel on major highways.
3. Fifty miles per hour was used when the bus was traveling along a major highway and not making stops.

A small sample of existing routes was compared with school districts' actual route times to test the results of the use of these roadway speeds. The comparisons indicated that these assumptions yielded results very close to the actual route times school districts were experiencing. In addition, the same process was used on both the existing routes and the routes to contiguous schools. Therefore, the comparisons of travel times for the two sets of routes should be consistent and valid. A sample set of existing routes to Highland High School, in Highland School District, are displayed in Appendix B. The routes to a contiguous school district for the bus stops displayed in Appendix B are displayed in Appendix C.

Travel Time Comparisons

Comparisons of travel times between current routes and routes to contiguous schools are included in Appendix D. Each school district receiving small school district bonus funding has the estimated time for each **existing route** identified with an entry in the column titled "Current Travel Time." The travel time for **contiguous routes** for each school district is identified with an

entry in the column titled "Contiguous Travel Time." The difference between the two is shown in the column titled "Diff." (or difference). A positive number indicates that it would take more time traveling to the contiguous school building. A negative number is indicated in parentheses. The final column title "Contiguous Building" shows the contiguous district or school building where the alternative route would end.
